

Pupil Voice...

In April we asked all pupils for their feedback on their school experience. 201 pupils answered. This is what they told us and what we're going to do to make it even better...



You told us...

That most of you **feel safe in school** (83%) but some of you feel unsafe at times.

What we're doing about it...

1. Teaching you about anti-bullying in lessons and in assembly
2. Teaching you about how to stay safe online in school
3. Making it clearer who you can turn to in school if you feel unsafe by putting up more posters around school and in the school toilets
4. Opening a lunch-time 'Nurture Room' so you have somewhere to go if you're feeling unhappy or unsafe at lunchtime
5. Setting up feelings 'Post Box' in the library so you can tell us about what's worrying you in confidence
6. Setting up Playground Friends so that nobody feels lonely at playtimes

You told us...

That most of you **feel safe at home** (95%) but a small number of you feel unsafe at times.

What we're doing about it...

1. Teaching you about how to stay safe online at home
2. Informing parents about how they can keep you safe online at home
3. Making it clearer who you can turn to in school if you feel unsafe by putting up more posters around school and in the school toilets
4. Setting up feelings 'Post Box' in the library so you can tell us about what's worrying you in confidence





You told us...

That most of you **feel that people in school care about you (78%)** and you **knew who you could speak to if you feel worried or upset (72%)** but some of you weren't sure.

What we're doing about it...

1. Making it clearer who you can turn to in school if you feel unsafe by putting up more posters around school and in the school toilets
2. Setting up feelings 'Post Box' in the library so you can tell us about what's worrying you in confidence
3. Making sure your class has a regular circle time to discuss concerns and feelings

You told us...

That most of you **can concentrate in class (78%)** and that you **find your learning interesting (73%)**, but we want everyone to feel this way!

What we're doing about it...

1. Teaching your teachers new techniques to explain your learning and model how to succeed
2. Making sure teachers give you regular 'Stormbreak' / Go Noodle movement breaks to help you concentrate
3. Reviewing your topics and key texts and asking for your feedback on this
4. Making sure that everyone can go on interesting trips linked to your learning
5. Making sure all of our teachers and TAs apply our behaviour policy fairly in class



You told us...

That most of you can think of **something that you're good at** (74%) but some of you weren't sure.

What we're doing about it...

1. Reviewing our after school clubs for next year to offer more variety
2. Taking part in more competitions and events including music, chess, football and cricket



You told us...

That nearly all of you **enjoy playtimes and lunchtimes** (92%) but we want all of you to enjoy your breaktimes!

What we're doing about it...

1. Setting up Playground Friends
2. Opening up the lunchtime Nurture Room
3. Improving our school dinners and the dining experience
